Modules and Subdivisions:

We will attempt to secure a copy of the "Windmill Ordinance" for Mr. Rinaldi. Next, Ed Harsch presented drawings for the "Matoushek/Drobnicki" subdivision #20022-10. After review, Matt Tomazic made a motion to accept the drawings and forward them to Wayne County for review. Mattb will also deliver the drawings. Brandon Cole seconded the motion.

New Business:

Matt Tomazic suggested that we might want to prepare for an ordinance concerning "Solar Farms", as he sees this as a possible future development. Joe Franceski will contact the Chairman of the supervisors to make this suggestion.


Dave Hauenstein's term is over at the end of December and has stated that he will be leaving his position on the planning commission. An effort to find a replacement will be discussed.

It was also suggested, that this might be a good time to ask all planning members about their desire to continue serving on the commission and to set guidelines for attendance to continuing on the commission.


Adjournment:
