Matt will deliver this package to the county office.


Other Business:

With planning commission member Brad Bates now also acting as a Township Supervisor, our board has 2 members on it that are also supervisors. It was asked if this could present a "conflict of interest" question. Joe Franceski was asked to contact the "State Association of Supervisors" and pose that question. Their response was as follows: "On a supervisor board consisting of 3 members, it is recommended that only one member also serve on the board of the planning commission. On a supervisor board of 5 members, it is recommended that 2 member could also serve on the board of the planning commission. But this is a recommendation only and does not pose any ethical issues, especially with the knowledge that in a smaller community it is difficult to find people to serve".

With no further business to attend to, Joe Franceski made a motion to adjourn at 723pm. Brandon Cole seconded the motion.
